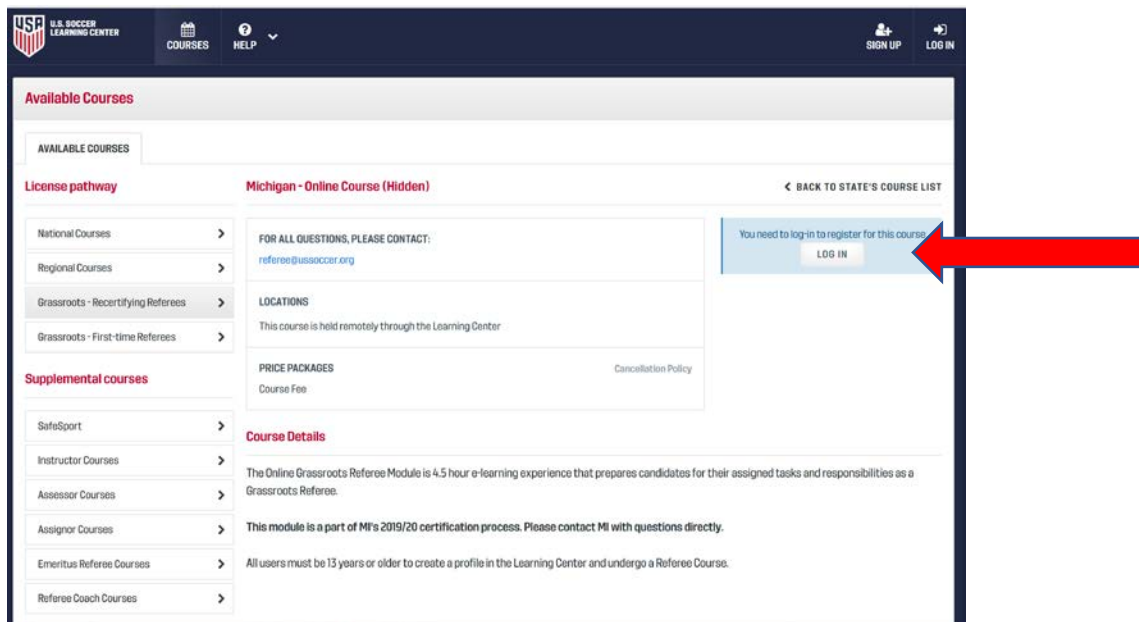


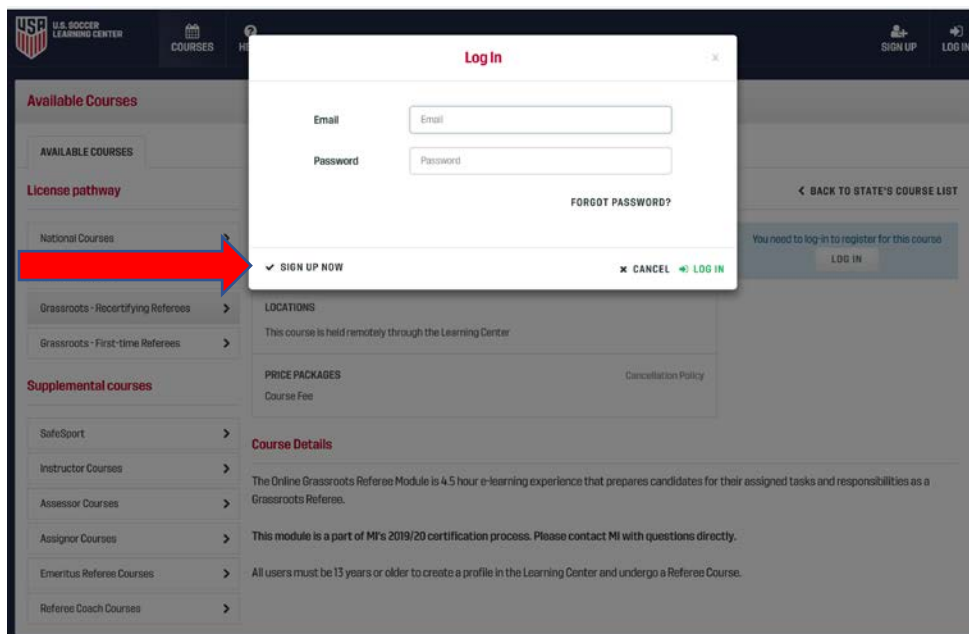

- After initial "Sign Up", users who have certified in the past will be able to connect to their certification history and have it visible on their profile, based on first name, last name, date of birth and/or email address.




